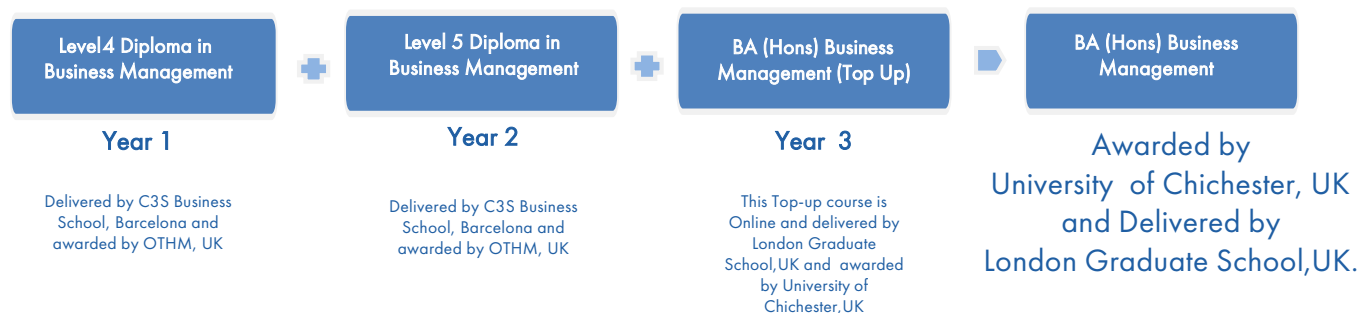
The content of the qualification is focused on:

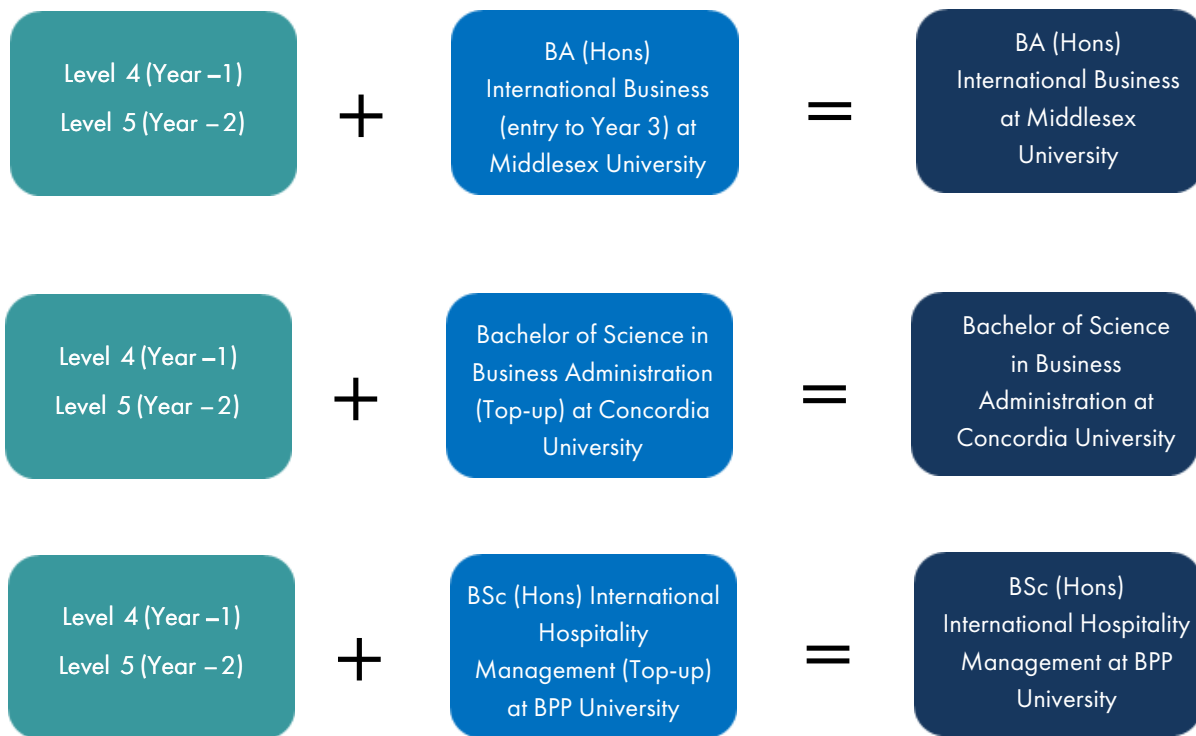

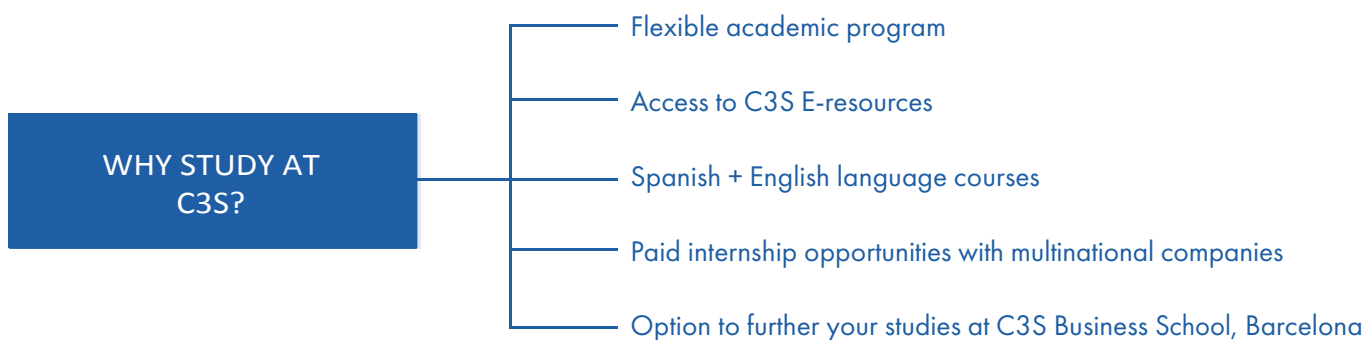
OTHM Level 4 & 5 qualifications are widely accepted throughout the world. As a result student can have multiple options to do double graduate in various field.
